Regulations

1. Applicants shall be current HKU staff members or students.
2. Not more than 3 entries are allowed for each applicant. Each applicant can receive at maximum 1 award.
3. Each entry shall include:
 - (i) A digital photo with an image resolution of at least 8 megapixels. The size of the file should not be larger than 8MB.
 - (ii) An entry form with information on the photo's title, location and year taken, and a caption of not more than 100 words in Chinese or English.
4. The work (including the photo and the caption) must be original and has not been published. The copyrights of the work shall not be owned by anyone except the applicant. Applicants shall undertake the sole responsibility for any claims or complaints by a third party in relation to the work submitted.
5. The work shall not contain any name or personal identification of the applicant.
6. The work must not, in the sole and unfettered discretion of the Organizer, contain obscene, provocative, defamatory, sexually explicit, or otherwise objectionable or inappropriate content; or intend to promote any personal, business, or political bodies.
7. No digital modification of the photos is allowed.
8. The decision made by the adjudication panel on the eligibility of the works and the adjudication results is final.
9. Submissions will not be returned in any circumstances. The Organizer reserves the right to use the submitted works for exhibition, publication, collection or promotional purposes.
10. Winners may be requested to provide the Organizer with a film of the photo or a higher-resolution computer file for publishing and publicity purposes. The copyrights of the publicity materials containing such photos and captions belong to the Organizer.
11. The Organizer reserves the right to amend the above regulations without prior notice.
